
Forum on Internet Freedom in Africa 2017 (#FIFAfrica17)

Co-organised by the Collaboration on International ICT Policy for East and Southern Africa (CIPESA) and the Association for Progressive Communications (APC), this meeting is taking place in Johannesburg, South Africa from 27 to 29 September 2017.




