



Internet Universality Indicators: what are they? how are they going to be used? Will they be able to influence policy? On 19 October, 2017, we discussed #InternetUniversality with @guyberger, director of freedom of expression of @UNESCO, in a Twitter-interview.

In 2015, UNESCO put the concept of "Internet Universality" at the heart of its work to promote an internet that works for all. Internet Universality points to four fundamental norms that have been embodied in the broad evolution of the Internet and which provide a comprehensive way to understand how multiple different aspects are part of a wider whole.



In June 2017, UNESCO launched a year-long programme of consultation to develop a set of Internet Universality indicators, covering these four fundamental norms and the cross-currents between them. A framework of quantitative and qualitative indicators will be developed to help governments and other stakeholders to assess their own national internet environments, and to promote the values associated with Internet Universality. Special attention will be paid to gender and to the needs and interests of children and young people.


